

Participation of representative of the State Statistical Committee in Regional Workshop organized in Almaty on “Information Management Preparedness & Response”

Representative of the State Statistical Committee Deputy Head of the Department on Coordination of Statistical Works – Gasim Aliyev was participated in Regional Workshop on “Information Management Preparedness & Response” organized by UNO for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs on 4-5 June, 2012 in Kazakhstan, Almaty. Beside the representative of the Republic of Azerbaijan also representatives of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Armenia, Georgia, Kirgizstan and representatives of the Regional Office on Central Asia and South Caucasus of UNO for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs were participated in the regional meeting.



Training meeting was fully dedicated to the preparation of emergency response, forming of central staff and creation of working groups, correctly and systematically distribution of local and international humanitarian aids, collection and analysis of data on number of population and infrastructure in the area of emergency, practical issues on emergency cases.

All presentations and lectures in two days meeting were presented by the experts of Regional Office on Central Asia and South Caucasus for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs. It was noted that, in most cases efficiency of humanitarian operations depend on existence of data and information. The main activity purpose of Regional Office on Central Asia and South Caucasus of UNO

is the support of training in emergency cases and the role of management of information. By this purpose, Coordination Office on Humanitarian Affairs of UNO is working in a close corporation with regional countries Caucasus and Central Asia.

During the meeting participants were informed about P-codes in different countries, their structure and the meaning of code.

Then the discussion was about duties of working group during the emergency case and state bodies, non-governmental organizations and mass media included them. Also discussion was about Geographical Information System, maps drawn before and after the emergency case and formation of this system.

Then the methodology was called MIRA was presented. MIRA is the result of working group forming immediately after the emergency case. MIRA was formed for the support of fundamental information about the injured people.

The delegation of Azerbaijan was actively participated in the practical trainings, discussions and during the resolving the tasks.
