

Representative of the State Statistical Committee participated in the Fourth meeting of the Technical Advisory Group (TAG) for population and social statistics



Deputy Head of Labour Statistics Department – Nemat Khuduzade as member of Technical Advisory Group for population and social statistics participated in the fourth meeting held on 25-27 November, 2013 in Bangkok, Thailand.

Experts from member countries to TAG Australia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, India, Indonesia, Iran, Mongolia, Philippine, Singapore, as well as, experts of invited international organizations (ILO, UNDP, ADB and UNESCAP) were participated in the meeting.

The fourth meeting of TAG aimed to further advance its work in developing a regional programme to improve national capacity in population and social statistics.

Specific outcomes from the fourth meeting were included: Recommendations to refine and finalize the draft document on the capacity framework for population and social statistics; Recommendations to refine and finalize the draft documents on the process and instrument of conducting strategic reviews (earlier referred to as “national reflections”) to identify gaps and challenges in national capacity in population and social statistics as well as opportunities for improvements; Recommendations on the process of developing a regional programme to improve national capacity in producing, disseminating and using population and social statistics in view of related developments, including the on-going discussions on formulating a post-2015 development agenda; Consideration and decision on options for including related issues within the regional programme, e.g. strengthening civil registration and vital statistics, ensuring population and social statistics are gender sensitive; and developing recommendations to meet information needs for addressing inequality (including but not limited to gender); A work plan for the remainder of the current term of the TAG (till the fourth session of the Committee on Statistics in December 2014 as per the Terms of Reference), including a list of tasks, outputs and schedule.

Representative of the State Statistical Committee presented his presentation on “Current production and dissemination condition of indicators on Population and Social Statistics: sustainable and weakness features in national and regional level” and it was carried out wide discussions on this topic.
