

Best practice of Azerbaijan in the field of energy statistics was discussed in the 7th working meeting of Oslo Group on Energy Statistics

Head of Department of Quality Management and IT - Y.Yusifov and Deputy Head of Department of Industry and Construction Statistics – R. Gurbanov were participated in the 7th meeting of Oslo Group on Energy Statistics of UNO held in Helsinki. The meeting was held by the purpose of preview to the structure and the draft of “the Energy Statistics Compilers Manual”, issues covered chapters and information on country practices.



Representatives of Australia, Azerbaijan, Canada, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, Ghana, Ireland, Mexico, Netherlands, Norway, Qatar, Korea, Russia, South Africa, Sweden and UAE including UNO, totally 36 experts were participated in the meeting.

New manual is consist of 9 chapters: conceptual framework, legal foundations and institutional arrangements, classifications, data source and data collection, compilation of energy balances, compilation on energy accounts, compilation of energy indicators, data quality and metadata and data dissemination. Participants of the meeting was informed about the “practice of Azerbaijan on compilation of energy” in the chapter of Compilation of energy balances by the help of presentation. Presentation was about the activities carried out during the compilation of balance, the structure of balance and covered products, use of report forms, conversion ratio, texts for manual, as well as country balance on 2011.

2 materials on practice of Azerbaijan were placed to the current version of manual. They were about the followings: legal foundations on country, State Program and meetings on energy statistics, adopted decisions and participation in the international meetings, quotations from report on global assessment of national statistical system, authorities of Committee on collection of data and etc.
