

The Results of 19th International Conference of Labour Statisticians organized by ILO in Geneva

The conference began with the speech of Director-General of ILO - Guy Ryder and in his speech he congratulated all participants with the 90th annual of Labour Statisticians Conference.

Representatives of ILO, UNECE, EUROSTAT, FAO, UNICEF, African Development Bank, World Bank, International Tourism Organization and other organizations as well as, representatives of countries participated in this conference.

Followings were discussed during the Conference: view to the International Standard Classification of Occupation (ISCO-08); Child Labour Statistics; Forced Labour and Human Trafficking; Statistics on Decent Work; Statistics on green jobs; Statistics on cooperatives; wage statistics; gender mainstreaming in the production of labour statistics; informal employment and informal sector; statistics on social dialogue; Statistics on labour migration; statistics on work-related violence; ILOSTAT database; Millennium Development Goals (MDG) indicators and the post -2015 Development agenda; view to International Classification of Status in Employment (ICSE-93) and Report of the Committee.

Report of the Committee was discussed in the last plenary session. The main question of discussion was the Resolution on Labour activity worked by the Committee.

The project of the Resolution was consisted of 12 parts.
