

Participation of Deputy Head of Department of Labour Statistics – Nemat Khuduzade in the first meeting of Expert Group on Measuring Quality of Employment

First meeting of Expert Group (consisting of experts of UNECE, ILO, OECD, Eurostat as well as National Statistical Office of Mexico, Switzerland, Moldova, Holland, Luxemburg, Italy, Israel, France, Finland, Canada, Germany, Australia, Azerbaijan) jointly organized by UNECE, Eurostat, ILO and Federal Statistical Office of Germany on Measuring Quality of Employment was held on 22-23 November, 2012 in Wiesbaden, Germany by the purpose of re-development and analyze of proper methodological documents as well as, indicators system according to the demands of 58th plenary session. As a member of expert group Nemat Khuduzade



participated in the first meeting.

According to the working plan adopted by UNECE main purpose of meeting were: re-developed conceptual document on measuring quality of employment, indicators system of 4 from main 7 considered for measuring quality of employment, discussion and agreement on methodology and explanations of these indicators, as well as, activities will be carried out in the next phase.

According to the working plan since beginning of February, 2012 all carried out activities by the representatives of member countries were carried out in the form of e-consultation.

During the meeting all participants presented presentations on rules of calculation and determination of each indicator, methodological explanations, offered data source, relations with other indicators, international comparison. Representative of the State Statistical Committee presented presentation on “working hours”, as well as, its sub indicator “employed person working more than one job”.

At the end of the meeting were decided to send final drafts of the conceptual document, indicators characterizing quality of employment and their methodological explanations (in the frame of 4 element) to the members of expert group via e-mail and to present comments to the secretariat till April, 2012 was appreciated. Discussion of the noted projects (or drafts) in 7th meeting on Measuring Quality of Employment to be held on September 2013 and the submission to CES Bureau to be held on October 2013 and 19-th International Conference of Labour Statisticians for approval was agreed.
