Participation of representatives of the State Statistical Committee in the workshop organized in Moscow on "Organization of Sample Survey"

Representatives of the State Statistical Committee head of the Department on Population Living standards and Household Budget Survey Head of Department Yashar Pasha and adviser of Department on Coordination of Statistical Works Shahin Sadiqli were participated in the workshop organized by CIS Interstate Statistical Committee and Scientific-Research University of the Russia- Higher School of Economics on 23-27 April of current year on "Organization of Sample Survey". Along with representatives of the Republic of Azerbaijan also representatives of Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kirgizstan, Uzbekistan, Moldova, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Ukraine (2 specialists from each) were participated in the workshop. Workshop fully dedicated to the organization of sample survey, assessment of main summery on sample data, studying of quality of indicators, application of SPSS program during processing of data.



Speakers participated in the workshop gave wide information on the followings: sample frame, base of sample, sample plan, calculation of probability, non-random sample, and main decisions during the organization of surveys. It was noted that, for carrying out efficient survey should be defined the purpose of survey, observation of units, and periodicity of observation, borders and methods. Multi-tier area sample starts with the selection of regions, cities and rural areas and settlements, and completed with the selection of households and respondents. In most cases in the probability sample volume of main summery, share of units that meet certain criteria of summery, average and final prices of signs and comparisons of indicators are estimated.

Then the method of carrying out sample survey of population on employment issues was discussed.

At the end of the seminar one specialist from each country presented their presentation on research methodology of households carried out in CIS countries.
